

Health and Safety Policy Cwm Dyli

The Pinnacle Club recognises that it has a duty of care to all who stay at or visit Cwm Dyli. It is the Hut Secretary's responsibility to develop and maintain a Health and Safety Policy for the hut on behalf of the club. It is also the Hut Secretary's responsibility to carry out a health and safety risk assessment which needs to be reviewed on a regular basis.

As part of the Health and Safety Risk Assessment the Hut Secretary will assess the following;

1. First aid provisions at the hut
2. Storage of flammable or toxic materials
3. Issues relating to steps and stairs and other internal structures
4. Safety in relation to heating and the stove
5. Fire safety by way of a fire risk assessment and the maintenance of alarm systems and fire emergency equipment.
6. Electrical safety and maintenance of electrical systems and appliances
7. Water supply contamination
8. Parking and access to the hut
9. Cooking facilities
10. Working safety and good practice on maintenance meets
11. Maintenance of ladders and equipment used at maintenance meets including the provision of safety gear where appropriate.

Following the Health and Safety Risk Assessment the Hut Secretary will make any simple improvements immediately and notify the committee of any significant issues so that an appropriate contractor can be commissioned to carry out remedial work.
