

Directions to the Emily Kelly Hut (GR SH 653541)

From the Pen y Gwryd pub, bear left towards Beddgelert and drive downhill for about five minutes.

Take the first turning on the right, which is a sharp turn into the Llyn Gwynant campsite (if you reach the lake, you have gone a bit too far).

Don't go into the campsite; drive all the way along the road (heading back on yourself, but in the valley bottom) until you reach a farmhouse with a cattle grid.

Head through the gate (usually need to get out and open it) .

Take the left turn down the steep, rough downhill track towards a power station (which looks like a church) at the foot of the black pipeline.

Open the metal gates at the bottom and go through. Hut users have permission inside these gates.

On the opposite side of the car park to the gates, there is a small wooden gate leading onto a narrow, stone bridge across the stream. Cross the stream and bear right up the grass track to the hut (1-2 minutes walk).
