

Directions to the Emily Kelly Hut (GR SH 653541)

Note that headtorches will be necessary for the short walk up to the hut from the car park if it's dark on arrival.

From the Pen y Gwryd Hotel, bear left towards Beddgelert and drive downhill for about five minutes. Note that although there is a tempting looking track towards the hut that starts nearer the Pen y Gwyrd, it's extremely rough and not worth risking except with a 4wd etc.

Look out for a small turning on the right, which is a sharp turn into the Llyn Gwynant campsite (if you reach the lake, you have gone a bit too far).

Don't go into the campsite; drive all the way along the road (heading back on yourself, but in the valley bottom) until you reach a farmhouse with a cattle grid.

Head through the gate (usually need to get out and open it) .

Take the left turn down the steep, rough downhill track towards a power station (which looks like a church) at the foot of the black pipeline. **N.B.** The track is unmade and usually has some bumps that can't be taken at speed.

Open the metal gates at the bottom and go through. Hut users have permission to park inside these gates.

On the opposite side of the car park to the metal gates, there is a small wooden gate leading onto a narrow, stone bridge across the stream. Cross this and bear right up the grass track to the hut (1-2 minutes walk).
